

I. SHPDA Administrative Report

A. Contested Cases

For the following projects no vote was required because the recommended order of the Administrative Law Judge becomes the final order of the Agency when no exceptions have been filed. No exceptions were filed.

AL2017-005, Proton International Alabama, LLC, Birmingham, AL: Proposes to develop and operate a freestanding Proton Therapy Center. **Opposition: Providence Proton Center filed opposition/intervention and requested a contested case hearing.**

AL2017-008, Providence Proton Center, Birmingham, AL: Proposes to construct and operate a freestanding proton therapy center on, or adjacent to, the campus of St. Vincent's Hospital. **Opposition: Proton International Alabama, LLC filed opposition/intervention and requested a contested case hearing.**

II. Certificate of Need Program

A. AL2016-037, The Health Care Authority of the City of Huntsville d/b/a Madison Hospital, Huntsville, AL: Proposes to add thirty (30) acute care beds pursuant to the *Alabama State Health Plan* Section 410-2-4-.02(5) Bed Availability Assurance for Acute Care Hospitals. **Opposition: None.**

B. AL2017-002, East Alabama Medical Center, Opelika, AL: Proposes to relocate the existing cancer center at 2501 Village Professional Drive in Opelika, replace the existing linear accelerator and add a second linear accelerator. **Opposition: None.**

Approved.

C. AL2017-003, LSREF Golden Ops (AL), LLC d/b/a Knollwood Pointe, Mobile, AL: Proposes to convert thirty-two (32) existing assisted living facility beds to specialty care assisted living facility beds pursuant to an adjustment to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e)(ii) of the Alabama State Health Plan. **Opposition: None.**

D. AL2017-004, Creekside-Trussville, LLC, Trussville, AL: Proposes to relocate sixteen (16) specialty care assisted living facility beds from Country Cottage-Magnolia, LLC located in Hoover, to a newly constructed facility in Trussville. **Opposition: None.**

E. AL2017-006, BBH WBMC, LLC d/b/a Walker Baptist Medical Center, Jasper, AL: Proposes to relocate twelve (12) existing inpatient psychiatric beds from Brookwood Baptist Medical Center. **Opposition: None.**

Approved.

- F. **AL2017-009, LiveOak Village, LLC, Foley, AL:** Proposes to establish a sixteen (160 bed Specialty Care Assisted Living Facility pursuant to Rule 410-2-4-.04(2)(d)(7) of the *Alabama State Health Plan*. **Opposition: None.**

- G. **AL2017-011, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius Kidney Care Narrow Lane Dialysis, Montgomery, AL:** Proposes to establish a new End Stage Renal Disease (“ESRD”) facility consisting of twelve (12) in-center hemodialysis stations and one (1) isolation station for a total of thirteen (13) stations. **Opposition: None.**

RV2017-002, Methodist Homes for the Aging d/b/a Fair Haven Retirement Community, requests to temporarily relocate Fair Haven’s existing thirty-two (32) SCALF beds to a newly-constructed building on Fair Haven’s campus in order to complete extensive renovations to an existing skilled nursing unit to establish a household-model SCALF facility. **Status: Non-Reviewable**

RV2017-006, St. Vincent’s East, requests to provide diagnostic services in a new leased space. St. Vincent’s currently provides diagnostic services on its main campus. **Status: Non-Reviewable**

RV2017-008, Leoti Dialysis, LLC d/b/a Tennessee River Dialysis, requests to establish a new ten (10) station ESRD facility consisting of eight (8) in-center hemodialysis stations, one of which will be a hemodialysis isolation station, and two (2) home training stations which may be used alternately for home hemodialysis training and peritoneal dialysis home training. **Status: Non-Reviewable**

Rural, Monroe County Health Care Authority d/b/a Monroe County Hospital, requests to provide in-home/outpatient hospice services in Monroe County. **Status: Non-Reviewable**

Rural, Monroe County Health Care Authority d/b/a Monroe County Hospital, requests to expand the existing emergency department and the corresponding relocation of the existing oncology department, to existing space within the hospital, to accommodate such expansion. **Status: Non-Reviewable**
