Whether advising small businesses and nonprofit organizations on business-related issues or helping military veterans receive critical health and education benefits, Bradley's attorneys and professional staff devoted over 17,500 hours to serving people and communities in need across the firm's footprint. A major highlight of 2025 was receiving the Exceptional Service Award from the ABA Death Penalty Representation Project for decades of service to death row prisoners. The firm received the same award in 2012, and we were honored to accept it again as a demonstration of our continued commitment to ensuring that those facing a death sentence have access to qualified counsel. Twenty-eight Bradley attorneys worked on behalf of individuals on death row last year, a number that has remained consistent for the firm for many years. We are grateful for everyone's contributions in 2025, and we look forward to increasing our pro bono impact in the coming year.

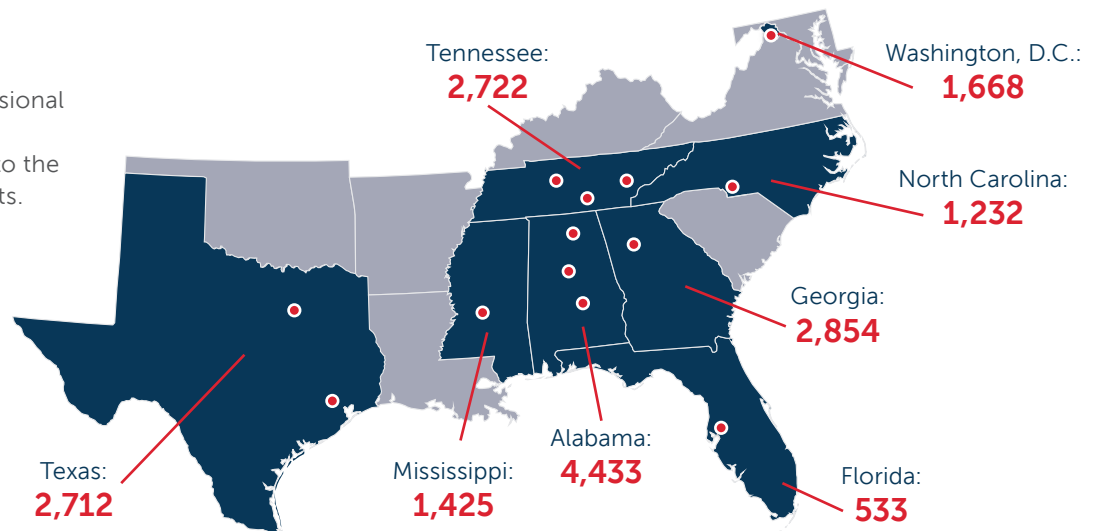

# 2025 AWARDS & HONORS HIGHLIGHTS



## **BRADLEY RECOGNIZED FOR PRO BONO SERVICE BY AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION'S DEATH PENALTY REPRESENTATION PROJECT**

Bradley was recognized with the "Exceptional Service Award" by the American Bar Association's (ABA) Death Penalty Representation Project for demonstrating an exceptional commitment to excellence in capital defense. The Death Penalty Representation Project is the ABA's expert on issues related to the defense effort in death penalty cases. Previously awarded the Exceptional Service Award in 2012, Bradley has represented 39 individuals across five states, 12 of whom were new clients since 2018. In 2025, 28 Bradley attorneys dedicated more than 1,000 pro bono hours to prisoners on death row. Over the years, six of Bradley's clients have been either exonerated or removed from death row.

## **NASHVILLE ATTORNEYS RECOGNIZED BY TENNESSEE SUPREME COURT AS "ATTORNEYS FOR JUSTICE"**

The Tennessee Supreme Court named 11 attorneys from Bradley's Nashville office as "Attorneys for Justice." The annual Tennessee Supreme Court recognition program was designed to increase statewide pro bono work to 50% participation. The attorneys recognized provided at least 50 hours of pro bono service in the previous calendar year. In 2024, the Tennessee Supreme Court expanded the program to honor attorneys who provided 100 or more hours of pro bono service. Charles E. Elder, Benjamin A. Johnson, Erin Malone-Smolla, William L. Norton III, Robert F. Parsley, and Luke R. Yordy reported more than 100 pro bono service hours in 2024, and Brandon Bundren, Marc Bussone, Elizabeth T. Petras, Rachel L. Sodée, and Thor Y. Urness reported 50 or more hours of pro bono service.

## **D.C. ATTORNEYS NAMED TO 2024 CAPITAL PRO BONO HONOR ROLL**

Katherine Henry, David Long, Jr., Erin K. Sullivan, John Parker Sweeney, and Timothy Willman, attorneys in the firm's D.C. office, were named to the 2024 Capital Pro Bono Honor Roll by the D.C. Courts for donating 50 hours or more of pro bono service during the previous calendar year. Ms. Henry, Mr. Long, Mr. Sweeney, and Mr. Willman were recognized with high honors for reporting 100 hours or more of pro bono service.
